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## WHAT ARE HEALTH REFORM ANALYSES

- Review of recent health reform that may have influence well beyond initiating jurisdiction
- Recognizes decentralized nature of Canadian health “system”
- Clear language description and analysis
- Based on literature as well as interviews
- Put into larger context
- Audience: policy decision-makers, influencers and scholars

## FORMAT (WITH EXAMPLES FROM ISSUE #1 ON LEAN)

1. Brief Description (of reform in question)
2. Goals of Reform
3. Factors that Influenced Adoption of Reform
4. How Reform Was (or Will Be) Achieved
5. History and Context
6. Evaluation
7. SWOT Analysis

Followed by references and some additional detail including links to media releases and government documents
