Background

The Early Psychosis Prevention and Intervention Service (EPPIS)

- Established 2003
- Intervention for those with first-episode of psychosis
- Based on previous early intervention programs
- Assertive community treatment (ACT)
 - Assertive case management
 - Community treatment

Emphasized:

- adherence to medication,
- psychotherapy (including group therapy),
- and involvement of family in treatment

Linked to MCHP data repository

EPPIS clients (2003-2012)

Historical controls (1998-2001)

Controls matched to diagnostic pattern of EPPIS clients prior to program entrance

Propensity-score adjustment for confounders

SAS macro used to identify potential confounders

Inverse-probability of treatment weights

Average Treatment Effect (ATE)

During and post-treatment period assessed

Odds ratios (binary variables)




