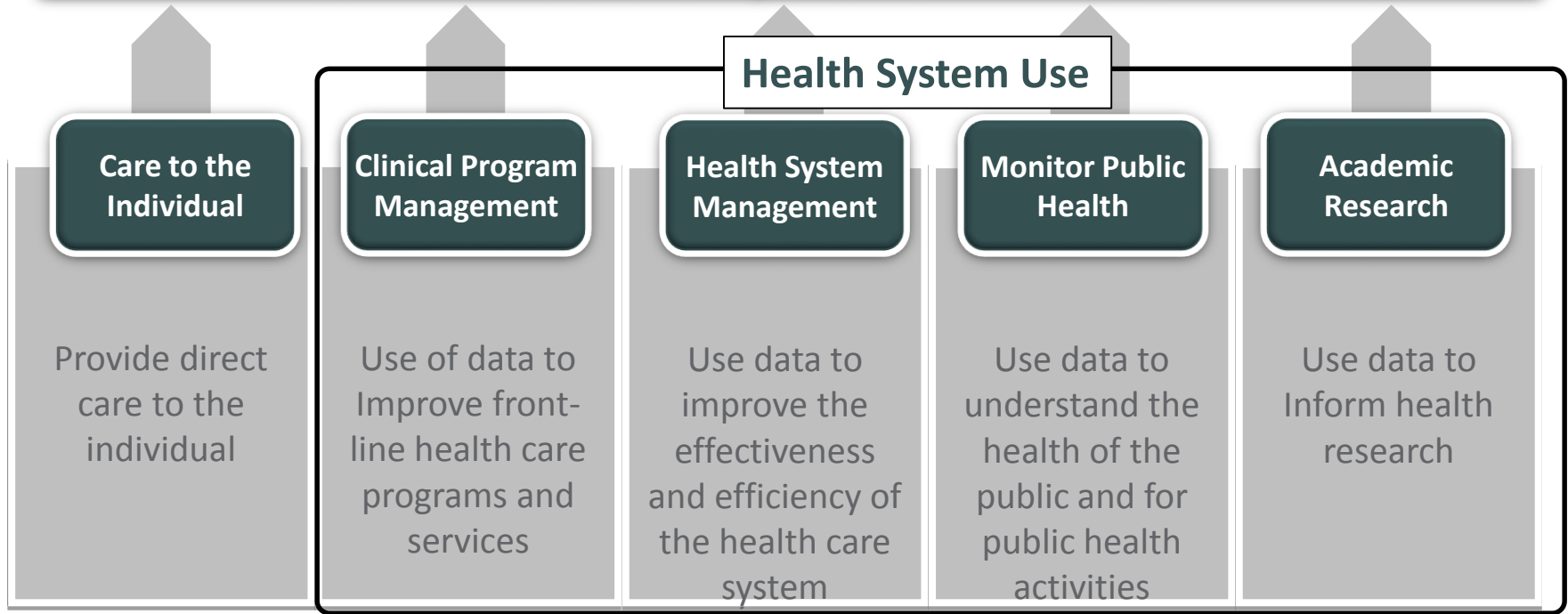

CIHI role and support for PRHDN
