## **DR. RACHEL D. SAVAGE** **2021 ARTICLE OF THE YEAR**

Rachel Savage is a Scientist at Women's Age Lab and Women's College Research Institute, Women's College Hospital, an Adjunct Scientist at ICES, and an Assistant Professor at the Institute of Health Policy, Management and Evaluation, University of Toronto. She completed her PhD in Epidemiology at the Dalla Lana School of Public Health, University of Toronto and her MSc in Epidemiology at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. At Women's Age Lab, Dr. Savage leads research focused on promoting social connectedness in older adults and supporting aging in place.



## **DR. FENG XIE** **2022 ARTICLE OF THE YEAR**

Dr. Feng Xie is a professor of health economics at the Department of Health Research Methods, Evidence, and Impact (HEI, formerly Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics) and Centre for health Economics and Policy Analysis (CHEPA) at McMaster University. Dr. Xie's research interests focus cost effectiveness analysis and patient-reported outcome measures to support clinical and economic evaluations. Dr. Xie has developed a program of research on measuring preferences and valuing health to support cost utility analysis in the context of drug pricing and coverage/reimbursement policy making.
