## **ANDREA EVANS - CO-CHAIR**

Dr. Andrea Evans is a general pediatrician at the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario (CHEO) and an epidemiologist at the School of Epidemiology and Public Health at the University of Ottawa. Her research focuses on child welfare and health disparities and she is dedicated to improving health outcomes for pediatric populations impacted by social determinants of health through policy-focused research. She is the scientific director of the CanFos project, which focusses on the health and wellbeing of children in foster homes across Canada. Through her work, Dr. Evans uses participatory research and relationship based research principles to authentically work with people with lived experience and communities.

## **LUCY BARKER - CO-CHAIR**

Dr. Lucy Barker is a Psychiatrist and Scientist (early career) at Women's College Hospital, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Toronto, and an Adjunct Scientist at ICES. Dr. Barker's research focuses on the interplay between reproductive health and mental health, and on equitable access to reproductive mental health services.



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
